Submission of Labeling - Labeling should first be submitted in the form of draft labels with all applications for new registration. Such draft labels may be in the form of typed label text on 8 1/2 x 11 inch paper or as a mockup of the proposed label. If prepared as a mockup it should be constructed in such a way as to facilitate storage in an 8 1/2 x 11 inch file. Mockup labels significantly smaller than 8 1/2 x 11 inches should be mounted on 8 1/2 x 11 inch paper for submission.

Submission of Data - Data submitted in support of this application must be submitted in accordance with PR Notice 86-5.

HOW TO APPLY: HOSE 'N GO WEED & GRASS PREVENTER will not kill existing weeds. Before applying HOSE 'N GO WEED & GRASS PREVENTER, remove any weeds, grass, fallen leaves and other plant debris. Rake area smooth, if necessary. HOSE 'N GO WEED & GRASS PREVENTER will cover 1000 sq. ft. of established annual and perennial flower beds, ground covers, ornamental beds, gravel walkways, driveways, etc.

Over application can cause damage to shrubs, trees and groundcovers. Do not apply to steep areas where runoff is possible. Do not use on dichondra or turfgrasses. Do not plant grass or shallow-rooted flowers and groundcovers (less than 4") in treated areas for 4 months following treatment. To prevent weed growth from occurring, do not disturb surface after treatment. Do not apply to or around vegetables.

To prevent staining avoid application to fences, sidewalks, patios, cement blocks, stucco or painted surfaces. If these surfaces are accidentally sprayed, hose off with water. May stain clothing.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

1. Connect spray nozzle to garden hose. Be sure valve is in "off" position. 2. Remove bottle cap and screw bottle onto nozzle. Turn on water. 3. Switch valve to "on" position to start flow of water. Use valve to shut off flow of water at any time. 4. Spray directly over area requiring application evenly and uniformly. 5. After application, turn on sprinkler or irrigation system for about 1 hour. Do not allow material to run off treated area.
