HOW TO USE AS A DOG REPELLENT: To repel dogs and prevent defecation and urination on lawns, around trees, shrubs, hedges, vines, and garbage containment areas - remove any fecal material and spread Lilly/Miller Dog and Cat Repellent evenly on affected area at the rate of 1 pound (2 3/4 cups) per 110 square feet (10 ft by 11 ft). Use gloves when applying or apply directly from container. This container will cover 330 square feet. Do not place in piles. Reapply once per week or until unwanted behavior stops. Resume treatment as needed.

HOW TO USE AS A CAT REPELLENT: To repel cats and prevent digging in lawns, flower gardens, under trees and shrubs - remove any fecal

material, fill existing holes and spread Lilly/Miller Dog and Cat Repellent evenly on affected area at the rate of 1 pound (2 3/4 cups) per 55 square feet (5 ft by 11 ft). This container will cover 165 square feet. Use gloves when applying or apply directly from container. Do not place in piles. Reapply once per week or until unwanted behavior stops. Resume treatment as needed.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Do not apply directly to plant foliage (except lawns). Do not apply to dichondra or unusual ground covers. Do not apply to painted surfaces. Do not use on or around edible food or feed crops.

Filled by weight, not by volume. Product may settle after packaging. If product becomes compacted in container, break up with stick or screwdriver. Product quality will not be affected.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not store inside house or pet living quarters. Do not reuse container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
