1. Submit/cite all data or other material required for registration/ reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 802-592."
 - b. Limit use of the product to residential sites only by adding the following statement to the front label:

. . . For use on residential lawns and
around residential premises only for
control of aphids, leafhoppers
 - c. Under Statement of Practical Treatment for "If Inhaled . . .," add " . . . Get medical attention."

d. Under Precautionary Statements, change the second to the last sentence to read as follows:

. . . Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.

Also, add ". . . causes moderate eye irritation"

e. Delete the following phrase under Environmental Hazards:

. . . or wetlands . . . marshes and potholes.

- 1. Delete the statement "Do not feed or graze animals in treated areas" since this is a residential use product.
- 9. Delete lettuce from the vegetable grouping since it is not an approved site for esfenvalerate.

Note that the labeling for the cited MGK products of which this product is similar have changed the signal word from Caution to Warning until additional data is submitted justifying a lowering of the signal word. Since this is a water dilution of the MGK products, the Agency is not requiring additional data at this time. However, additional data may be required after evaluation of the MGK products.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE PRECAUTION

Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not feed or graze animals in treated areas.

Muskmelon (3), Pears (), Stone Fruits including peaches, Apricots, Nectarines, Plums, Prune Plums, Cherries (all 14).

Control Aphids (Apple, Rosy Apple, Black Cherry), Apple Maggot, Borers* (Peach Twig, Peach Tree, Lesser Peach Tree, American Plum), Cherry Fruit Fly, Codling Moth, Green Fruitworm, Leafhoppers, Leafrollers, Lesser Appleworm, Oriental Fruit Moth, Pear Psylla, Pear Slug, Periodical Cicada, Plum Curculio, Tarnished Plant Bug, Tentiform Leaf Miner, Tufted Apple Budmoth, San Jose Scale, Stink Bug, Western Cherry Fruit Fly.

*For Borer control, spray to thoroughly cover trunk and lower limbs.

NUTS

Almonds (21), Filberts (21). Control Naval Orangeworm, Peach Twig Borer, Filbert Worm, Oblique Banded Leafroller.

LAWNS

Control Fleas and Ticks. For best results, lawn should be mowed a day or two before application. Spray to evenly cover lawn areas frequented by pets. Spray under ornamental trees and shrubs, but avoid soaking foliage. Repeat at 7 to 14 day intervals as necessary for control. Kills on contact the Ixodes demmini tick (deer tick) which transmits Lyme disease. Also kills foraging fire ants upon direct contact. A product labeled for treatment of fire ant mounds should be used in conjunction with this product. Keep children and pets off treated areas until spray has dried. Do not spray animals with this product. Pets and their bedding should be treated with an EPA-registered product approved for direct application to pets, such as Lilly/Miller Sevin brand carbaryl insecticide 5% Dust. Follow label directions.

CONTROL MIGRATING PESTS OUTDOORS

Control migrating insects such as Grasshoppers, Saltmarsh Caterpillar, Armyworms, Army Cutworms, and Chinch Bugs which may be a threat to your yard and garden. Spray border areas, but do not apply to edible crops not listed on this label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse container. Rinse container and hose-end attachment before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
