**DIRECTIONS:**

**1. SPOT OR TRAIL BAITING**

- (a) Place one teaspoon of bait in surface trails or at the mouth of holes leading to underground burrow systems.
- (b) Two to four bait spots should be made at the base of each affected tree.
- (c) Cover bait by pulling overhanging grass back into place. Do not disturb runway system.
- (d) Baiting should be conducted at the rate of 2 to 3 pounds per acre.

**2. BROADCAST BAITING**

- (a) Can be applied by Aircraft, Cyclone spreader, or by hand. By hand throw tablespoon amounts into heavy cover along tree rows, rock outcrops, and fence lines.
- (b) Apply at the rate of 6 to 10 pounds per acre.
- (c) Do not broadcast over growing crops.

**3. MACHINE BAITING**

- (a) Use a modified corn planter with plates set to drop one Kernel per inch along a line just inside the drip line of both sides of a tree.
- (b) Bait should be applied at the rate of 3 to 6 pounds per acre.
