

DIRECTIONS: Moles — Locate main runways by either rolling the turf or tamping the runways. Runways that are opened within 24 hours are the main runways. At intervals of 8 to 10 feet, insert a probing stick and drop in 4 or 5 pellets. Close the openings by covering with a piece of sod, a stone or other means so as to disturb the tunnel as little as possible, yet seal out the light.

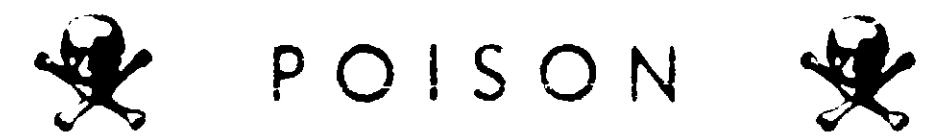
