The current version of the sentence could be interpreted to mean that rats can be controlled by tablespoons alone. We apologize for not detecting this problem when we originally drafted text for your label.

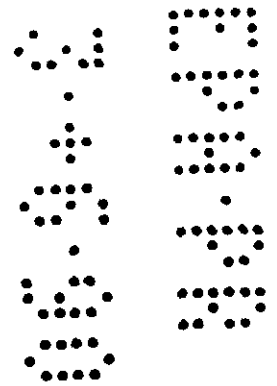

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE RESTRICTIONS: To control house mice (Mus musculus) and Norway rats (Rattus norvegicus) in and around houses and commercial, industrial and agricultural buildings. Bait must be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals, and nontarget wildlife or in secured, tamper resistant bait stations. Do not use bait where it might contaminate food, feed, or surfaces that come into contact with food or feed.

Wear gloves when handling bait or animal carcasses. Collect and bury all dead animals found above ground.

HOUSE MICE:

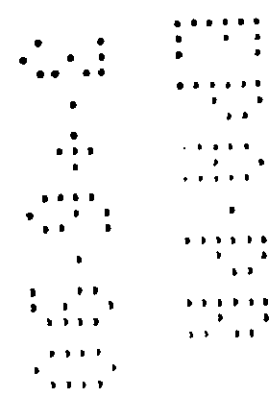
Inside buildings, place tablespoon quantities of bait at 8- to 12- foot intervals along walls or other vertical structures in areas where signs of mouse activity (tracks, droppings, live rodents) have been seen. If treated areas are accessible to children or nontarget animals, bait must be applied in secured, tamper-resistant bait stations.

Outside buildings, secure tamper-resistant bait stations along walls at a density of not more than one station per 8 feet of wall. Place a tablespoon of bait in each station. Move away from building stacked wood, debris, tall vegetation, and other objects that could serve as harborage.

NORWAY RATS:

Inside buildings, place two tablespoons in protected locations (along walls or other vertical structures) in areas of rat activity. If treated areas are accessible to children or nontarget animals, bait must be applied in secured, tamper-resistant bait stations.

Outside buildings, secure tamper-resistant bait stations along walls where rat activity has been detected or is suspected. Place two tablespoons of bait in each station. Move away from building stacked wood, debris, tall vegetation, and other objects that could serve as harborage.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Any persons applying zinc phosphide products and experiencing signs and symptoms such as nausea, abdominal pain, tightness in the chest, or weakness, should be seen by a physician immediately.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1-2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with the finger. Avoid the use of all oils. Have the person lie down and keep warm. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets. May be fatal or harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Avoid eye or skin contact.

Use rubber gloves if contact with skin may occur when placing baits. Avoid Contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Avoid contact with acid. Wash hands thoroughly after use.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Baits exposed on soil surface may be hazardous to birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
