PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS (& DOMESTIC ANIMALS)

DANGER

MAY BE FATAL IF SWALLOWED. VAPOR CAN BE HARMFUL IF INHALED. Do not get in eyes, on skin. Avoid breathing vapor. Wash thoroughly after handling.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

RE-ENTRY

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool, dry place to prevent expansion of contents which can be caused by excessive heat.

Keep containers closed. Do not store near heat or other sources of ignition.

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved state and local procedures.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- Vault fumigation with EDB formulations may be conducted only by certified commercial applicators in commercial fumigation vaults.
 - Demolishing Cabinets: 2 quarts
 - Vaults: 1 gal per 1000 cubic feet
 - Where practical — Temperatures of 70° to 85° desirable.
 - Keep Demolishing Cabinet or Storage Vault closed for up to 24 hours after fumigant is added (See unit operating instructions).
 - A full-face black canister respirator approved for use with EDB by MSHA/OSHA, and EDB-resistant gloves (butyl rubber only) and boot covers and apron (made of butyl rubber, nitrile or polyethylene) must be worn by the applicator at all times during the treatment.
 - Before fumigation, all doors and leaks in the vault must be sealed.
 - Following the treatment period, a full-face black canister respirator approved by MSHA/OSHA for EDB must be worn during reentry. All doors and vents in the treatment area and connected buildings must be opened at this time. Before workers may reenter the vault without a respirator, the vault must be aerated to reduce EDB air levels to the OSHA workplace standard.
 - Fumigated areas must be placarded on all entrances with signs containing at least the signal word DANGER and the words "Area under fumigation, do not enter until completely aerated," the date of fumigation, name of the fumigant used, emergency telephone number for contact and the name and address of the fumigator. Do not remove warning signs until the fumigated area is completely aerated and safe for entry, as indicated by a suitable detector.
 - HAERTEL TRI-X FUMIGANT is Non-Flammable-Non-Explosive.
 - Vapors of TRI-X are intended to kill moths etc. and quite naturally should not be inhaled by humans.
 - Positive kill of Moths, Larvae, Eggs, Silverfish.
 - Use in all commercial fumigating systems. Not for household use.
- General garment fumigant use only in Demolishing Cabinets or Garment Storage Vaults.
