

CONTROLS MANY WEEDS

In addition to dandelion, this herbicide will knock out plaintain, buckhorn, mustard, shepherd's purse, spotted spurge, black medick, and dock with one treatment as directed. Certain hard-to-kill weeds, such as clover, chickweed, ground ivy, henbit, pennywort, wild garlic, wild onion, sawtooth, and many other weeds, require a second treatment seven to ten days after the initial application. The second treatment should be applied when the weeds are young and growing vigorously.
