The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.



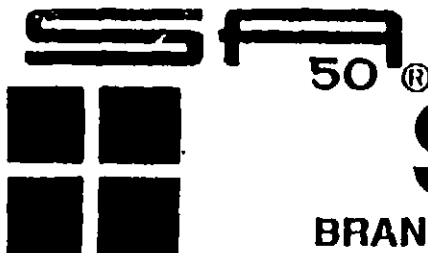

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR Part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval of 12 hours.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is: coveralls, waterproof gloves, shoes plus socks.

BEANS to control Mexican bean beetle and bean leaf beetle. Apply 60 lbs. per acre to foliage as needed.

CUCUMBERS and SQUASH to control cucumber beetles. Apply 60 lbs. per acre to foliage as needed.

POTATOES and TOMATOES to control Colorado potato beetle. Apply 75 lbs. per acre to foliage as eggs begin to hatch. Repeat as needed.

May be used to day of harvest on listed crops except as otherwise indicated.

NOTE: Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated soils must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl label(s).

Dosages are indicated for maturing plants. Use proportionately less when applied by ground equipment to smaller plants. Do not exceed maximum indicated dosages. Before applying consult proper state extension authority to determine if local recommendations are consistent with this label. This product may injure tender plant parts particularly when applications are uneven, or when plants are wet, or when applications are made during periods of sustained high humidity.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. **STORAGE:** Store pesticide in the original container in a locked storage area. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** To dispose of excess pesticide, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.
