Subject: Revise Precautionary Statement  
SA-50 Brand Bait Pellets Kill Land  
EPA Registration No. 829-182  
Resubmission of June 22, 1994

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submitted and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling with the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment.
  - a) Revised the precautionary statement to include the following:  
 "This pesticide may be fatal to dogs or other pets if eaten. Keep pets out of treated area."
  - b) The active ingredient (Metaldehyde) must be declare as:  
 Metaldehyde (2,4,6,8-tetramethyl-1,3,5,7-tetraoxycyclo-octane).....3.25%
  - c) Add the heading "Storage and Disposal" directly above the storage and disposal statement.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

 Note to Physician - Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use as an aid in the control of land snails and slugs.

Apply to soil surface around plants. In greenhouses where tomatoes and ornamentals are grown. In plant beds, fields, and gardens where tobacco, ornamentals, ornamental turfs, and the following food crops are grown: Beans, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, eggplant, lettuce, okra, pepper, and tomatoes.

Distribute pellets evenly around plants using 1 lb. per 1000 square feet. When applying to areas planted in food crops, do not contaminate edible parts of plants. Do not apply to lettuce within 14 days of harvest, to broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage or cauliflower within 3 days of harvest.

When slugs are moving from a known area into a planting, pellets may be placed in a "guard line" at the edge of the planting. Pellets should be applied in late afternoon. Pellets will be less effective when placed in very dry locations. Applications should be repeated at 10-day intervals as necessary to maintain control. Three applications at 10-day intervals should cover a complete life cycle of snails or slugs.

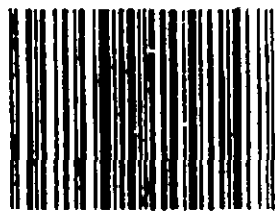
Keep children, pets and domestic animals from treated areas until pellets have disintegrated.

**NOTE:** Subsequent planting of food and feed crops in treated soil must be made with crops on this or other carbaryl label(s).

Pesticide should be stored in the original container and placed in a locked storage area. Dispose of Pesticide waste by securely wrapping the original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.
