IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water and change to freshly laundered clothing. See a physician if skin irritation occurs.

Apply DURSBAN .5G granular insecticide Informly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational furl grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using DURSBAN .5G at the rate of 200 pounds per acre. To help obtain unform distribution, apply one half required amount of product in one direction; then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 1000 gallon soft water per acre so as to wash the granules Into the zone of insect intestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of DURSBAN .5G and water needed for smaller sized areas. Re-treat as necessary.
