

Dursban Lawn Insecticide controls Chinch Bugs, Sod Webworms, Cutworms, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Crickets and Sowbugs (Pillbugs) infesting home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas. Mix Dursban Lawn Insecticide with water according to directions given in the following table. Apply as a coarse (large droplet) spray using a low pressure sprayer such as a hose attached applicator, compressed air or power operated sprayer. For best results, lawn should be moist at the time of application. Care should be taken to obtain complete and uniform coverage. Spray when pests first appear; re-treat when needed.
