DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Karathane is especially effective for the control of Powdery Mildew and certain Mites on Roses, Ornamentals and Flowers. Karathane is a wettable powder and should be mixed with water at the rate of 1 teaspoonful per gallon. The addition of a spreader sticker such as SA-50 Brand Polyethylene Spreader Sticker will aid in spray retention. Apply spray mixture in a manner that will uniformly coat both upper and lower surface of foliage. Begin applications when disease is first observed and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed.

ROSES — (Outdoor, including Rose Multiflora) For the control of Powdery Mildew and Red Spider Mite. For control of Black Spot, use A-50 Brand Dithane M-45 or SA-50 Brand Lawn, Ornamental and Vegetable Fungicide alone or in combination with Karathane.

FLOWERS — Aster, Larkspur, Begonia, Belladonna, Delia, Chrysanthemum, Calendula, Delphinium, Gerbera (Faneval daisy), Hydrangea, African Violet (Saintpaulia) and Snapdragon for control of Powdery Mildew, Red Spider and Clover Mites.

ORNAMENTAL TREES AND SHRUBS — Lilac, Hydrangea, Euonymus, for the control of Powdery Mildew, Red Spider and Clover Mites.
