STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product may not be used against any pests not named on the label.

This product may be applied under the direct supervision of a certified applicator who is not physically present at the site of application, but is, nonetheless, available to the person applying the pesticide.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Dispose of in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.

GENERAL: Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.

IMPORTED FIRE ANTS: For use on non-food and non-feed producing land. Do not use on land which will be used for food or feed production or grazing for two years after treatment.

Apply by Mound Application only using 1½ to 3 lbs. of this product to the entrance of the nest as well as to an area 3 feet around the mound. Treated areas should be examined 3 weeks after treatment and surviving colonies retreated. Do not apply when soil is wet. Do not apply broadcast or by serial application.
