The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

The following specific comments pertain to your WPS labeling submission concerning the product cited above:

User Safety Recommendations must either be placed in a box or printed on the label in a contrasting color from surrounding text.

Add the following User Safety Recommendation to the label: "Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing."

Delete the crossed out statements on your proposed label. They are redundant statements or phrases.

Correct the typographical errors circled on your proposed label.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT ORGANOPHOSPHATE

IF SWALLOWED: Wash mouth out with water. Give victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. Contact physician or poison control center immediately.

IF IN EYES: May cause irritation. Corneal injury is possible. Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water and shange to freshly laundered clothing. See a physician if skin irritation occurs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted-entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker enter into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 12 hours.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is: coveralls, waterproof gloves, and shoes plus socks.

NON-AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

The requirements in this box apply to uses of this product that are NOT within the scope of the Worker Protection Standard for agricultural pesticides (40 CFR Part 170). The WPS applies when this product is used to produce agricultural plants on farms, forests, nurseries, or greenhouses. Keep children and pets off treated area until subsequent rainfall or irrigation has washed the bait into the soil and the area is dried.

MOLE CRICKET CONTROL IN LAWNS, GOLF COURSES AND OTHER ORNAMENTAL TURFS: Apply at rate of 150 lbs. per acre (3 1/2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.). Spread evenly over the area using a mechanical spreader that has been calibrated to give the indicated coverage. Apply in late afternoon on moist soil areas known to be infested with mole crickets.

Rain or irrigation will reduce the effectiveness of this bait. Avoid application when impending rain is forcast. Withold irrigation for 2 or 3 days after harvest.

Repeat application in about one wek for best control. Best results will be obtained when applications are made when crickets are in the nymphal stage (usually June, July and August).
