Submission dated September 11, 2000, acceptable with comments.

Dear Ms. Huffman:

The Agency has reviewed your submission for a revised label, and the following comments apply:

- 1) You must add <u>commercial</u> before ornamental nurseries under the listed use sites (non commercial use is not allowed by the MOA).
- 2) The REI must be changed to 24 hours.
- 3) The reentry for golf course turf must read "keep the public (including children and pets) off treated area until...." on page 2 in the non-ag use box.
- 4) The word "lawn" must be changed to "turf" (bottom of page 2).
- 5) In the disposal statement the statement "securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash" must be removed and the proper disposal statement must be placed depending on the container type. The container type must be specified on form 8570-1.
- 6)The appropriate pesticide disposal statement must read "wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of at approved waste disposal facility."
- 7) Container disposal statement must read "Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration."
- 8) You must submit the final printed label before releasing the product to market.

You may choose to use the First Aid statement recommended by PR Notice 2000-3.



READY TO USE INSECTICIDE BAIT FOR THE CONTROL OF MOLE CRICKETS INFESTING TURF ON GOLF COURSES, SOD FARMS ROAD MEDIANS AND ORNAMENTAL NURSERIES

ACTIVE INGREDIENT:

Chlorpyrifos: O,O-diethyl O-(3,5,6-trichloro-2-pyridinyl)

CAUTION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. MOLE CRICKET CONTROL INFESTING TURF IN GOLF COURSES, SOD FARMS, ROAD MEDIANS, ORNAMENTAL NURSERIES AND AROUND INDUSTRIAL PLANT SITES

Apply at rate of 3 1/2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (150 lbs. per acre). Spread evenly over the area using a mechanical spreader that has been calibrated to give the indicated coverage. Apply in late afternoon on moist soil areas known to be infested with mole crickets.

Rain or irrigation will reduce the effectiveness of this bait. Avoid application when impending rain is forcast. Withhold irrigation for 2 or 3 days after application.

Repeat application in about one week for best control. Best results will be obtained when applications are made when crickets are in the nymphal stage (usually June, July and August).

Follow instructions carefully. Timing and care of application, weather and lawn conditions, and other factors influencing the results obtained by the use of this product are beyond the control of the seller. Buyer assumes all risks of use, storage, or handling of this material not in strict accordance with the directions and precautions given herewith.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store this pesticide in original container in a locked storage area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container, Discard empty bag in trash.
