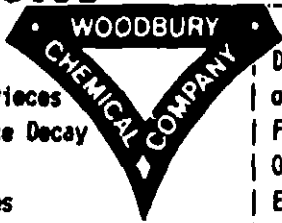

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENTS

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician of Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply Artificial Respiration if needed.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Do not use 2-PAM, Opiates, or cholinesterase inhibiting drugs.
