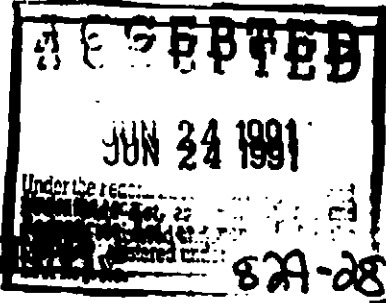

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply Artificial Respiration if needed.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons.

FOR MIXERS, LOADERS AND APPLICATORS

HANDLE THIS PRODUCT ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT
A long sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands, and feet, chemical resistant gloves, shoes, socks, and goggles or a face shield. During mixing and loading, and the placement of seed pieces into the soil, a chemical resistant apron must be worn. **IMPORTANT!** Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking, or drinking. Always wash hands and arms with soap and water before using the toilet. After work, take off all clothes and shoes, shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes. Do not use contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment heavily contaminated or drenched with Mancozeb must be destroyed according to state and local regulations. **HEAVILY CONTAMINATED OR DRENCHED CLOTHING CANNOT BE ADEQUATELY DECONTAMINATED.**

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seed. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

CHEMICAL OR PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Keep away from fire and sparks. Do not allow product to become wet or overheated in storage, a condition which may generate flammable vapors. Keep container tightly closed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Potato Seed-Piece Fungicide is a special fungicide dust formulation for application on whole or cut potato tubers to protect them from seed-piece decay caused by *Fusarium sambucinum* and seed borne common scab.

Use 1 lb. of Potato Seed-Piece Fungicide per 100 lbs. of whole or cut potato seed-pieces. Apply the dust in such a manner that the entire surface of the seed-piece becomes thoroughly covered with the dust.

Place potato seed-pieces in clean containers, and plant as soon after treatment as possible. (Refer to **WORKER SAFETY RULES** for details on required protective clothing (Gloves, etc.) when using this product. After treatment spread "coated seed-pieces" in a cool dry place if held before planting. Containers used must be labeled.

WARNING: POTATOES TREATED WITH MANCOZEB. DO NOT USE FOR FOOD.
Do not use treated seed for food or feed purposes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store product in original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. Keep container tightly closed.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
