Dilute as directed. Do not mix with soap or anionic detergents.

GENERAL DISINFECTION, SANITIZATION AND DEODORIZATION IN PUBLIC ROOMS, NURSING HOMES, HOSPITALS: After cleaning, mop, sponge or spray a solution of 1½ ounce of LECCO 15 per gallon of water.

SANITIZATION OF GLASSWARE, SILVERWARE, DISHES, COOKING UTENSILS: Clean with c suitable detergent. Rinse thoroughly and then immerse in a sanitizing rinse of LECCO 15 mixed according to use dilution shown on left panel. Rinse with potable water and air dry. Do not use a towel. This solution is effective in water containing up to 550 ppm hardness. Follow the recommendations of your health department.

SANITIZATION OF EQUIPMENT IN MEAT AND FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly. Then scrub with solution of LECCO 15 mixed according to use dilution shown on left panel. Flush equipment with a clear water rinse before re-use.

COLD DISINFECTION OF SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS: Clean thoroughly and rinse. Immerse in a solution of 1½ ounces of LECCO 15 per gallon of water for ten minutes. One tablespoon of sodium nitrite should be added to each gallon of solution as a corrosion inhibitor.
