DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove clothing and wash skin with soap and water. Shake container and spray liberally on exposed skin areas. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Repeat when insects become annoying. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks, and around openings of clothing. SCAT is especially formulated to resist perspiration.
