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- **b.** The phrase "for food contact and nonfood contact surfaces" must be revised to read "For use on food contact surfaces."
- c. The phrase "Ideal for water sensitive areas" must be removed. The phrase may be confusing to consumers when determining where to use the product.
- d. Under the heading Directions for Use, instructions must be added describing the necessity for removal of gross food particles and soil by a pre-flush, or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-soak treatment. In addition, instructions must be provided for thoroughly washing the surfaces or objects with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse prior to application of the sanitizing solution.
- e. Under the heading Directions for Use all wording involving non food contact must be removed because no nonfood contact surface data was submitted. This includes any mention of "other hard nonporous surfaces."

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply with a sponge, cloth, or mechanical sprayer, or by total immersion. When applied with a mechanical spray, spray should be coarse. Surfaces must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 1 minute. SANITIZING OF FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT

AND OTHER HARD NONPOROUS SURFACES IN FOOD CONTACT LOCATIONS:

For sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment, food utensils, dishes, silverware, glasses, sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other hard nonporous surfaces. Wash and rinse all articles thoroughly, then apply this product. Apply to sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by sponge, cloth, brush or coarse spray. Surfaces should remain wet for at least one minute followed by adequate draining and air-drying. Use fresh solution in all applications. Dishes, silverware, glasses, cooking utensils and other similar size food processing equipment can be sanitized by immersion in this product. No potable water rinse is required.

This product is an effective sanitizer against Staphykacoccus aureus (ATCC 8538) and Escherichia coli (ATCC 11229) on hard nonporous environmental surfaces. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 60 seconds. Allow to air dry.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant 1 high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not or linarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical medical devices prior to sterilization or high level disinfection.
