It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply with a sponge, cloth, or mechanical sprayer, or by total immersion. When applied with a mechanical spray, spray should be coarse. Surfaces must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 1 minute.

GENERAL CLEANING

Use as is. Do not dilute. Apply Wyandotte Sanifect D2 to soiled area with a mop, cloth, sponge, or hand pump trigger sprayer. Thoroughly wet soiled surface with product and scrub as necessary. Follow with potable water rinse.
