DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF DAIRY CLEANER — SANITIZER

CLEANER-SANITIZER SOLUTION:

DISSOLVE 3 LEVEL TABLESPOONFULS POWDER IN 12-QUART PAIL OF WARM WATER— (110-120°F.)

AFTER MILKING

1. Flush machine with warm water. Dilute remainder of rinse solution to one pailful with warm water and rinse milking machine by sucking through machine. Re-use for rinsing milk from other milker units and utensils. Discard.
2. Prepare a fresh cleaner-sanitizer solution in warm water. Disassemble milking machine and soak parts several minutes in this solution. Then brush all parts thoroughly and rinse in the solution. Then discard this solution.
3. Drain equipment. Use potable water to thoroughly flush equipment and to rinse all treated surfaces. Store dry until next milking.

BEFORE MILKING

1. Assemble milking machine and rinse with warm cleaner-sanitizer solution by sucking through the machine. Save this solution. Drain completely. Rinse with potable water before using the machine.
2. Re-use this cleaner-sanitizer solution to treat pens and other equipment. Save the solution and use about 2-3 pailful for washing udders. Rinse all surfaces including cows udders with potable water after treatment with cleaner-sanitizer solution.
