

**DIRECTIONS FOR WASHING EGGS:**

1. Dissolve 1 oz. (one measure) of AFCO 2626 for each 3 gallons of water (110°F.-130°F.) Maintain wash solution at even temperature. Very dirty eggs may require slightly more AFCO 2626.
2. For hand washing or immersion type machines, temperature 110°F.-130°F. immerse eggs for not more than 3 minutes. Remove from solution, allow to drain. Do not wash more than 5 dozen eggs per gallon of solution. Change solution oftener if it becomes dirty.
3. For washing eggs in spray and tank type machines follow manufacturers directions, using 1 oz. AFCO 2626 for each 3 gallons of water.
4. If separate rinse is used, add one oz. AFCO 2626 per 5 gallons of water. Maintain rinse solution at a temperature slightly greater than wash solution, but not over 140°F.
5. Dry eggs rapidly after sanitizing and store in cool, damp room.

**CONDITIONING EQUIPMENT AND BASKETS**

**IMPORTANT:** Equipment and baskets must be conditioned the first time AFCO 2626 is used. Dissolve 1 oz. AFCO 2626 per gallon of water. Place baskets in washer, heat to operating temperature, operate machine for two hours. Allow solution to remain in over night. Discard solution, rinse equipment. Repeat if necessary. Proceed to wash eggs as directed.

**DIRECTIONS FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND SANITIZING:**

1. Prepare a hot solution containing 1 oz. (one measure) AFCO 2626 per 2 gallons of water.
2. Wash feed hoppers, water founts and other equipment thoroughly. In case of a disease outbreak rinse with fresh solution after cleaning.
3. Wash equipment, walls and floors of egg handling rooms to reduce bacterial contamination and mold growth.
4. Use AFCO 2626 solution to wash hatching eggs, incubators, trays and other equipment to help reduce sploders.
