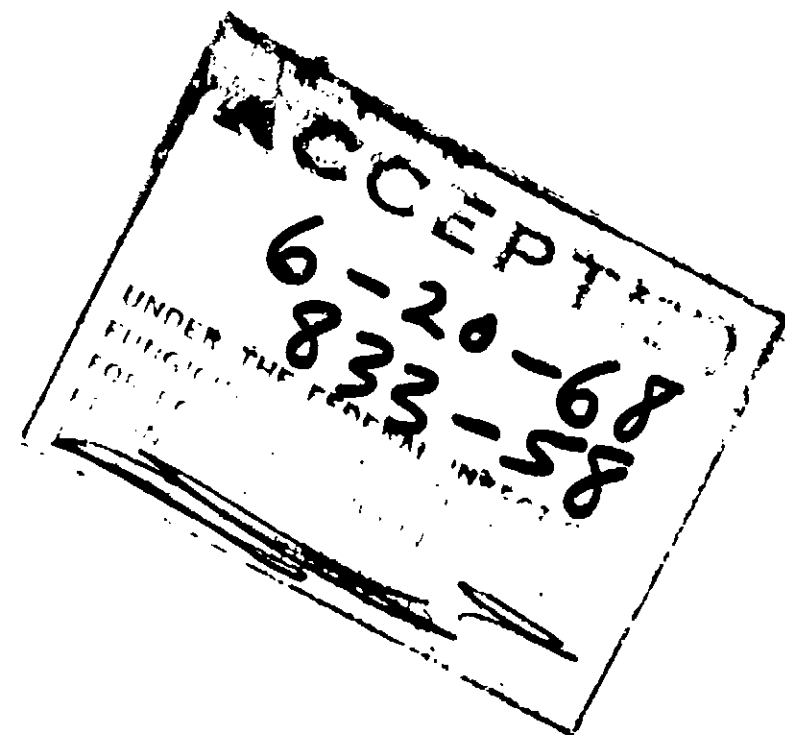

**DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING WITH AFCO TOPS**

**FOR SANITIZING:** Prepare a solution of sufficient volume by adding 1 oz. of Afco Tops to every 2 gallons of water. Use stainless steel or plastic containers. Sanitize equipment by circulation, immersion or spraying. Allow a 2 minute exposure period or contact time specified by governing sanitary code. Do not rinse unless required by local health authorities and then only in accordance with established regulations.

1. Clean equipment immediately after use.
