

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

SWIMMING POOL ALGAECIDE

The initial dose when algae are first visible is 1 quart of VIGILANCE per 10,000 gallons of water, followed the next day by the removal of settled algae debris and a dose of 1 gallon per 25,000 gallons of water. After the above treatment the weekly dose of 1 gallon per 50,000 gallons should be applied every 5 to 7 days, depending on temperature and sunlight. A clean and freshly filled pool with no visible algae may be treated initially with 1 gallon per 25,000 gallons followed by the weekly dose. When bathing load is increased add more frequently. Also after every rainfall add 1 quart to 50,000 gallons.

VIGILANCE suppresses algae growth and keeps pool water sparkling clear.

VIGILANCE is compatible with chemicals used in pool water treatment and will not damage tile and concrete found in pool systems.

DAIRY EQUIPMENT, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, MEAT PLANTS, RESTAURANTS, BARS, HOSPITALS.

After surface has been cleaned and rinsed use ¼ ounce of VIGILANCE per gallon of water for sani-

tizing. Rinse sanitized equipment with potable water before reuse.

For hospital use and very porous and difficult to clean surfaces use 1 oz. per gallon of water.

For disinfecting surfaces, walls, floors, equipment and utensils in Food Processing Plants, Bars and Restaurants use ¼ ounce of VIGILANCE per gallon of water.

In all cases where equipment or utensils are to be brought into contact with food, rinse with potable water after sanitizing and disinfecting.

DANGER:

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent from swimming pools should not be discharged where it will drain in lakes, streams or ponds.

Rinse empty container with water and discard.
