**General comments:**

The following label revisions must be made:

1. Add the statements "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal" below the storage and disposal subheading. The storage and disposal statement must be displayed as follow:

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** .....

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are hazardous. Improper .....EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse ..... stay out of smoke.
