The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

to revise the "first aid" statement in accordance with PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

Under the "First Aid" Statement add the following: 1.

For Toxicity Category I eye and skin irritants, use the following "Note to Physician".

"Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage".

Place "net content" in front of the 55 gallons on the front panel of the label. 2.

The correct name for this product is "Chlorilizer Plus" and not "Chlorilizer Plus AFCO 3. 0251". If you wish to change the name of your product, you must submit to the Agency an amendment requesting a product name change.
