

GENERAL INFORMATION: Belco G-P CONCENTRATE INSECTICIDE is a high quality contact insecticide exclusively formulated for use by wholesale grocers, food jobbers and packers, poultry processing plants, candy companies, carbonated beverage bottlers, seed firms and similar food and drink industries. Belco G-P CONCENTRATE INSECTICIDE may be sprayed around packaged nuts, fruits, candies and other similarly packed food. It is to be used for the control of flies, roaches, exposed stages of flour moths, ants, silverfish and certain other insects.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Area to be sprayed should be first thoroughly cleaned by removing all dirt and debris from cracks, crevices, pallets, shelves, as well as on and around packages and stored food products. Close doors, windows and ventilators in the area to be sprayed and keep closed for 15 to 20 minutes after spraying. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area treatment is completed. Sweep up all fallen insects and place in trash receptacle.

Belco G-P CONCENTRATE INSECTICIDE should be sprayed in the area in such a manner that a fine mist will settle in a thin film on all containers and packages sprayed. Also spray under and around all equipment, shelves and racks, into all cracks, crevices and corners as well as on ceilings, walls and floors.

Belco-G-P CONCENTRATE INSECTICIDE should be sprayed once a week as a regular procedure. During the summer, however, spraying should be conducted twice weekly. Where there are severe infestations, daily spraying may be necessary. For maximum penetration, we recommend using a fogger or sprayer.
