Meyer's Beatsall Fog Spray contains pyrethrum extract, in combination with Piperonyl Butoxide. The synergistic results obtained from such a combination provide a finished insecticide with rapid knockdown and excellent mortality to many insects, such as clothes moths, and the exposed stages of Mediterranean Flour Moths, Indian Meal Moths, and Cocoa or Chocolate Moths.

Directions for Use

Meyer's Beatsall Fog Spray has been compounded with the proper proportion of each of the active ingredients to give a rapid knockdown and a high surface kill on clothes moths and the exposed stages of grain pests. We recommend its use in the Microsol Unit or Challenger Sprayer, which may also be purchased from Theodore Meyer Inc., and should be used at the rate of 1 1/4 fluid oz. per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog at cracks and other hiding places of stored grain pests, and upward from beneath handling clothing (for clothes moths) so as to penetrate seams and folds.

To insure best results the vapors should be left in the space treated for at least one hour before airing. Treatments should be repeated as often as necessary, at least every three weeks.

If moths or stored grain pests are deeply seated in the affected material, consult us regarding fumigation.

**CAUTION:** Beatsall Fog Spray is inflammable. Keep away from open flames or sparks, as the fog could explode. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Cover Fish Bowls and remove Caged Birds before applying.
