HOW TO USE

CLEANING AND DISINFECTING Dilute one part of disinfectant with 100 parts of luke warm water (1/2 pint of disinfectant in 25 quarts of water). Pour water onto disinfectant for quicker emulsification. Thoroughly wet all surfaces that are to be disinfected with the above recommended use dilution. Use this solution for scrubbing, mopping or wiping floors, woodwork, sinks, wash basins, basements, telephone booths and washroom surfaces. It aids in removing grease, dirt and odors in public places, schools, hotels, theatres, homes, offices and industrial buildings.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING TOILETS AND URINALS Use a solution of 1/2 pint of disinfectant to 25 quarts water (1/100 use dilution), then wet surfaces thoroughly and use above solution for wiping, mopping or scrubbing surfaces of vessels, toilet seats and floors. When finished pour solution down drains to aid in deodorizing.

SPRAYING Use a solution of 1/2 pint of disinfectant in 25 quarts of water (1/100 use dilution) for spraying in public places to deodorize and to obtain a pleasing aroma of lustrous pine.

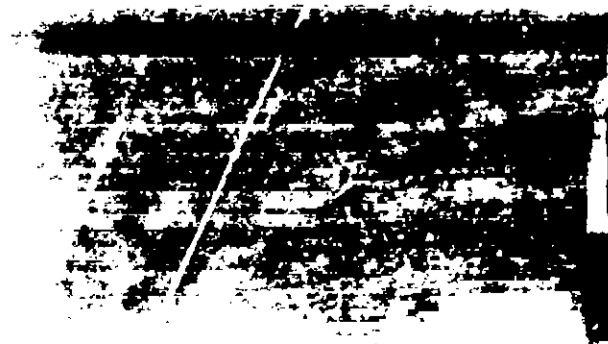
Rinse surfaces thoroughly with water and discard.

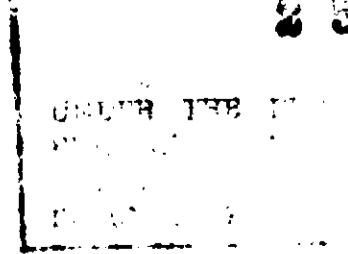

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING TOILETS AND URINALS: Using a solution of 1/2 pint to 10 quarts water, wash thoroughly the entire surface of vessels, toilet seats and floors. When finished, pour the solution down the drains to aid in deodorizing.

SPRAYING: Use a solution of 1/2 pint disinfectant to 10 quarts water for spraying in public places for deodorizing and getting an aroma of pine trees.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
