oughly cleaned before using. When using this
product in these areas, apply only when the
facility is not in operation.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums
before spraying.

DIRECTIONS

For indoor use only. Do not contaminate
water by cleaning of equipment or disposal
of wastes. Apply this product only as spec-
ified on this label.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS:
Close room and discharge spray mist vigor-
ously in all parts of room, using about 2-3
ounces for each 1000 cubic feet of space.
Leave room closed for 10-20 minutes. Repeat
when needed. Do not remain in treated areas.
Ventilate the area after treatment is com-
pleted.

TO KILL FLEAS (infesting premises):
Remove and destroy animal's bedding and
spray sleeping quarters freely, forcing the
spray into all cracks in the floor and around
the room. Spray floor coverings as well as
the floor. Repeat treatment as often as
necessary.

**TO KILL CLOTHES MOTHS, CARPET
BETTERIES:** Spray all articles to be protected
giving particular attention to folds and
seams. Spray carefully from a distance of
two or three feet so that only a mist like
vapor comes in contact with material being
sprayed. Interior surfaces of storage con-
tainers such as closets, chests and trunks
should be regularly sprayed. For the control
of carpet beetles thoroughly treat base-
boards, rugs and carpets, cracks in floor,
in corners and under furniture where the
insects tend to congregate and cause dam-
age. Treatment for clothes moths or carpet
beetles should be repeated every thirty days
unless articles are stored in moth tight
containers.

**TO KILL ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVER-
FISH:** Apply liberally in all cracks and crev-
ices in woodwork, underneath sinks, dark
places behind pipes and in all places where
insects may infest, contacting as many in-
sects as possible. Repeat application as
often as necessary.

TO KILL BED BUGS: Springs and mat-
tresses should be sprayed thoroughly after
the bed has been dismantled, paying par-
ticular attention to cracks, crevices, tufts
and seams on mattresses, wall paper that
is loose, loose moulding and any places
where these bugs are likely to hide. Repeat
treatment as often as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS: Use spray, so as to wet or
many insects as possible, thoroughly treat
runways, door sills, window frames, and
other points of entry.

**TO KILL THE FOLLOWING ACCESSIBLE
STAGES OF GRANARY INSECTS:** Granary
weevils, rice weevils, Indian meal moths,
angoumois grain moths, grain mites, con-
fused flour beetles, sawtooth grain beetles,
red grain beetles and codellies. Wet sur-
faces thoroughly and treat all infested sur-
face areas, insect hiding places and insect
runways at the rate of one gallon of this
material on 750 square feet of area - equi-
valent to spraying to point of run off. Re-
peat when needed.
