The amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable provided that you make the following labeling revisions:

1. Delete the word "Sanitizer" from the front panel.
2. The statement "Includes Ethylenediaminetetraacetate" from the front panel.
3. Delete the phenolic coefficients from the front panel.
4. Revise the heading "Directions " to read "Directions for Use."
5. Delete the phrase "General Classification."
6. Delete the word "milk."
7. In the "Note to Physician" section delete the following statement "Measures against may be needed."
8. In the Storage and Disposable section, delete the phrase "bury in a safe place."
9. Delete the word "Sanitization" from the subheading "General Disinfection."
10. Under the subheading, "In Public Rooms and Homes" delete the word "Sanitizing."
