1. In the Directions for Use, replace the word "may" with the word "must" in the sentence describing application equipment, ie. "This residual Insect Spray is ready to use undiluted as it comes from the can, and must be applied with either power operated or hand pressurized sprayers."

2. The Child Hazard Warning ("Keep Out of the Reach of Children") must appear above the signal word, Caution, and must also be in the same type size as the signal word.

Please make these changes at your next label printing, or within the next 60 days, whichever comes first.
