The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted subject to the comments reflected on the enclosed sheet. WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. Any other labeling changes submitted in connection with this amendment application but not directly related to compliance with the WPS have not been reviewed or accepted by the Agency. If you wish to make such changes, you must submit a separate amendment application proposing them. If your product is currently suspended, the acceptance of this labeling amendment does not affect the suspension in any way.

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Keep oil container tightly closed in storage to prevent entry of water. Spray only when temperature is above 40°F and there is no danger of freezing. Store drum on side. Roll drum before use if stored overseason.

GENERAL

Do not apply when plants are in or near wilting. Observe all cautions and limitations on labels of products recommended for mixture with oil.

DO NOT USE

11E in combination with or immediately preceding or following applications of Chloropropylate, Captan, Dinitro Compounds, Dyrene, Dikar, Dichlone, Folpet, Karathane, Morestan, Morocide, Sulfur Compounds, Omite and Sevin. Check tank mixtures for physical and chemical compatibility. Mix only enough material to do the job.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

- 1. Add sufficient water to the mixing tank to allow proper agitation by pump or paddles.
- 2. Add other desired pesticides, mixing thoroughly prior to the addition of oil.
- 3. Add oil under agitation, when 3/4 full topping off with water to form milky solution.
- 4. Maintain agitation until solution is used.
- 5. In small equipment lacking agitators, stir or shake diluted spray frequently during application.
