**Directions for Use:**

It is a violation of Federal law to use the product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

For the control of Yellow Sigatoka Disease (pathogen = *Mycosphaerella musicola*) on banana and plantain leaves. Apply 1 gal/acre (9.1 liters/hectare) of Sunspray 8B. Sunspray 8B can be applied to the foliage by using a motorized knapsack air blast mist sprayer, backpack spray gun equipment, airplanes or helicopters. Repeat application every 14 days during the rainy season and every 21 days during the dry season.

Certain compatible fungicides have been used with oil to control Yellow Sigatoka Disease. Please check the label of the specific fungicide for compatibility and dosage information.
