FLOORS: Mop floors, walls with solution of 1½ ounces Pine Oil Disinfectant per gallon of water.

TOILETS: For disinfecting and deodorizing, mop surface with solution of 2 ounces disinfectant per gallon of water.

LAUNDRY: Spot heavily soiled areas with undiluted Pine Oil. In main wash, use ½ ounce Pine Oil per gallon of water. Helps clean and deodorize.

INDUSTRIAL USES: Dissolves caked-on grease and soils, and many paints.
