

**READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING

FOR ANTS —

To control red harvester ants and fire-ants dust hills thoroughly and mix dust in top 2 or 3 inches of soil with rake or hoe. For other small ants in flower beds and in lawns, dust lightly over flower beds and lawns.

FOR PESTS IN YARD —

To control scorpions, centipedes, crickets, fleas, mole crickets, earwigs, chiggers, ticks, fall army worms, saw bugs (pill bugs), stink bugs, grass termites, and sod webworms or lawn moths, dust area where pests are found at the rate of one pound Many Purpose Dust to 1,000 square feet. Water lawn before application and do not water for several days thereafter.

FOR FLOWER GARDENS —

To control thrips, grasshoppers, flea beetles, army worms, cucumber beetles and leaf miners attacking such flowers as chrysanthemums, roses, dahlias, nasturtiums, and zinnias, dust plants thoroughly.

SOIL INSECTS —

To control cutworms, rootworms, and wire worms in flower beds and lawn grasses, dust ground at rate of one pound of Many Purpose Dust per 1,000 square feet before planting. Work dust into top 3 or 4 inches of soil.
