**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**Regular Mixture:** 8 ounces per 25 gallons of water or 1 tablespoon per 1/4 gallon of water, except when otherwise stated in directions.

**RED ANTS, FIRE ANTS,** and others nesting in non-crop land or non-pasture areas such as lawns, cemeteries, right-of-ways, vacant lots, pour 1 pint to 2 quarts of mixture in hole of ant nest.

**LAWN PESTS:** For ants, sod webworms, fall armyworms, crickets, mole crickets, tarantulas, scorpions, fleas, chiggers, wood ticks, sow bugs, spray regular mixture at the rate of 1 gallon per 100 square feet. Do not water lawn for several days afterwards.

**FLOWER, SHRUB, AND ORNAMENTAL TREE PESTS** such as grasshoppers, May beetles, flea beetles, wasps, spiders, mosquitoes (in shrubbery), spray plants thoroughly with regular mixture.

**SARCOPTIC MANGE MITES and LICE ON DOGS:** Wet animal thoroughly with regular mixture. Do not spray dog if suckling young, nor on cats.

**WARNING:** Do not use on humans or cats. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing spray mist and skin contact. In case of spillage on skin, wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Keep children and pets off treated lawns until insecticide is washed into soil and grass is completely dry.

This product will kill fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be harmed. Keep out of lakes, ponds, and streams. This product is toxic to bees and should not be applied when bees are actively visiting the area. Do not apply to any area not specified on this label.

**ANTIDOTE:**  
 External—In case of spillage on skin, wash promptly with soap and water.  
 Internal—Emetic of 1 tablespoonful of mustard in tumbler of water. Call a physician.
