**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN**

This product contains, Malathion, an organophosphate that inhibits cholinesterase. If symptoms of cholinesterase are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal, but should be administered only in conjunction with atropine. Contains petroleum distillate—vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

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**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life stages of amphibians. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organism areas near application site. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. 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### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

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**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Spray thoroughly covering both upper and lower leaf surface of plants. Apply 2 teaspoons in 1 gallon of water. Repeat as necessary. Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in ornamental gardens or lawns and grounds.

**VEGETABLES: Tomatoes**—For control of Aphids, Spider Mites. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest. **Beans**—For control of Aphids, Cucumber Beetles, Lygus Bugs, Leafhoppers, Spider Mites. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest. **Peppers**—For control of Aphids, Pepper Maggots. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest. **Cucumbers**—For control of Aphids, Leafminers, Cucumber Beetles, Pickleworm, Squash Vine Borer, Spider Mites. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest. **Lettuce (Head and Leaf)**—For control of Aphids, Leafhoppers, Cabbage Looper, Spider Mite. Do not apply within 7 days of harvesting Head Lettuce; 14 days of harvesting Leaf Lettuce. **Onions (Bulb and Green)**—For control of Onion Maggots, Onion Thrips. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest. **Potatoes (White)**—For control of Aphids, Grasshoppers, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs. May be applied on the day of harvest.

**ORNAMENTALS: Flowers, Shade Trees, Shrubs**—For control of many insect pests including: Aphids, Spider Mites, Bagworms, Leafminers, Japanese Beetles, Leafhoppers, Thrips, Lace Bugs, Mealybugs, Whiteflies, Tent Caterpillars, Scale.

**NOTE:** Injury may occur on Ferns, Viburnum, Lantana, Crassula, Canareti Juniper, and Petunias.

**FRUITS: Strawberries, Peaches, Grapes**—For control of Aphids, Leafhoppers, Mealybugs, Spider Mites, Spittlebugs, Thrips, Whiteflies, Strawberry Leafroller. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest on strawberries and grapes; 7 days on peaches. **Grapefruit, Oranges**—For control of California Red Scale, Citricola Scale, Purple Scale, Soft Brown Scale, Yellow Scale. Do not apply when trees are in bloom. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

**NUTS: Pecans**—For control of Phylloxera, Fall Webworm, Walnut Caterpillar, Pecan Casebearer, and Aphids. Contact your local Cooperative Agricultural Extension Specialist for timing of sprays.

**MOSQUITO CONTROL:** Apply 8 tablespoons (4 ounces) per 1 gallon of water for control of adult mosquitoes. Spray outside along building foundation and under shrubbery.
