DIRECTIONS FOR USE

When powdery mildew, rust, or red spider first appear and attack the plants, start dusting plants thoroughly with GREEN LIGHT DUSTING OR WETTABLE SULPHUR, or spray plants thoroughly with 2 tablespoonfuls of GREEN LIGHT DUSTING OR WETTABLE SULPHUR in one gallon of water, or 2 lbs. of SULPHUR in 32 gallons of water. Repeat application at 7 day intervals as necessary.

For powdery mildew on: Roses, chrysanthemums, zinnias, crepe myrtle, euonymus, hollies, sweet peas, beans, and peas.

For rust on: Roses, beans, carnations, chrysanthemums, hollyhock, snapdragons, and peas.

For red spider on: flowers, shrubs, or vegetables.

NOTE: Do not use GREEN LIGHT DUSTING OR WETTABLE SULPHUR on cucurbits. Do not use SULPHUR on plants if temperature is 95°F. or above.
