

DIRECTIONS FOR USE



When powdery mildew, rust, or red spider first appear and attack the plants, start dusting plants thoroughly with Green Light Wettable Dusting Sulphur, making sure to get dust on both bottom as well as top of leaves. Or spray plants thoroughly with 2 tablespoonfuls of Sulphur in one gallon of water, or 2 lbs. of Sulphur in 32 gallons of water. Repeat application at 7-day intervals as necessary.

FOR POWDERY MILDEW ON: Roses, chrysanthemums, zinnias, crepe myrtle, euonymus, hollies, sweet peas, beans, and peas.

FOR RUST ON: Roses, beans, carnations, chrysanthemums, hollyhock, snapdragons, and peas.

FOR RED SPIDER ON: Roses, chrysanthemums, zinnias, crepe myrtle, euonymus, hollies, sweet peas, beans, and peas.

FOR BROWN ROT AND SCAB FUNGUS ON: Peaches and plums. Use 2 tablespoons of Sulphur per gallon of water or 2 lbs. in 32 gallons of water. Consult local County Agricultural Extension Agent for timing spray applications for peaches and plums.

NOTE: Do not use on cucurbits. Do not use on plants if temperature is 95° F. or above.

Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.
