Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Wash hands after handling. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE: Store in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Store in original container. Do not store near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Unwanted material leave in original container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Discard can in trash.

When the following pests first appear on plants, start dusting or spraying thoroughly with Green Light Wettable Dusting Sulphur. Make sure to get dust or spray on tops and bottoms of leaves. To make spray, mix 2 tablespoons of sulphur in 1 gallon of water or 2 pounds of Sulphur in 32 gallons of water. Repeat application at 7-day intervals as necessary.

NOTE: Do not re-enter treated area for 24 hours after treatment is made.

Tomatoes: Russet Mites, Red Spiders.

Roses: Rust, Powdery mildew, Red Spiders.

Peaches, Plums, Cherries, Prunes: Brown Rot. Consult local county agricultural extension agent for timing spray application.

Apples, Pears: Scab. Spray when buds begin to swell and at 10-day intervals until after petal fall.

Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Hollyhock, Shadblows: Rust.

Chrysanthemums, Zinnias, Crepe Myrtle, Euonymus, Hollies: Red Spider.

Peas, Beans: Rust, Powdery Mildew, Red Spider.

Chrysanthemums, Dahlias: Powdery Mildew.

NOTE: Do not use on Cucurbits. Do not use on plants if temperature is 95 F or above. Do not use Sulphur in combination with oil emulsion, or within 3 to 4 weeks of an oil spray treatment.
