The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable with the following change:

The directions for use for chigger control should indicate a reapplication interval since the presence of chiggers is not visibly noticeable. Currently registered products for this use indicate that sulfur should be applied weekly.

Please submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

**PHYSICAL HAZARDS:** Keep away from heat, sparks, or open flame. Do not smoke while applying this product.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **DO NOT USE INDOORS.**

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** When the following pests first appear on plants, start dusting or spraying thoroughly with Green Light Wettable Dusting Sulfur. Make sure to get dust or spray on bottom as well as top of leaves. To make a spray solution (except for chiggers), mix 2 tablespoons in 1 gallon or 1-1/2 pounds in 24 gallons of water. Repeat application at 7 day intervals as necessary.

**REENTRY STATEMENT:** Do not re-enter treated area for 24 hours after treatment is made.

**FOR RUST ON:** Roses, Beans, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Hollyhock, Snapdragons and Peas.

**FOR RED SPIDER MITES ON:** Roses, Chrysanthemums, Zinnias, Crape Myrtles, Euonymus, Hollies, Beans, Peas and Tomatoes.

**FOR BROWN ROT ON:** Peaches and Plums, and **SCAB FUNGUS ON:** Apples and Pears. Use 2 tablespoons of Green Light Wettable Dusting Sulfur per 1 gallon of water or 1-1/2 pounds in 24 gallons of water For Peaches and Plums, apply at bloom or early petal fall. Repeat as necessary at 10 to 14 day intervals. Consult local County Agricultural Extension Agent for timing spray application.

**FOR CHIGGERS:** In Lawns, Ornamental Beds, Shrubs and Around the Home or any other similar area outside. Put 1 pound of Green Light Wettable Dusting Sulfur in a no-clog sprayer and fill sprayer to the top with water. Shake thoroughly. Attach sprayer to hose, turn on water and begin applying product. This one pound of product will treat 375 to 500 sq. ft. of area. Reapply as needed.

Green Light Wettable Dusting Sulfur may also be applied dry (as is). Dust thoroughly the area to be treated. Two pounds of product will treat 750 to 1000 sq. ft. of area. Reapply as needed.

**NOTE:** Do not use on cucurbits. Do not use on plants if temperature is 95 F or above. Do not use Green Light Wettable Dusting Sulfur in combination with oil emulsion, or within 3 to 4 weeks of an oil spray treatment.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Store in original container. Do not reuse container. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not contaminate feed, food or water by storage or disposal.
