HOW TO USE

- Dilute with water as per directions below.
- Spray plants thoroughly, making sure to get underside of leaves wet with spray.
- May be used in combination with Green Light General Spray for spring and summer spray to control hard-to-kill insects such as tea scale on camellias, white and red scale on euonymus, and certain other pests.

Peaches	San Jose scale	Mix 10 tablespoons in gallon of water or 1 quart in 6 gallons water. Repeat application at 2 to 3 week intervals until scale is controlled.

PLANTS	INSECTS	DILUTIONS
Camellia	Tea scale	Mix 5 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water or 1 quart in 12½ gallons water. Repeat at 2 to 3 week intervals until pests are controlled.
Azalea	Azalea scale Mealy bugs Red spider	
Euonymus	Euonymus & red scale, mealy bugs	Note: Do not spray plants when temperature is above 90° F. for a period of 24 to 48 hours as it may injure the plants.
Rose	Rose scale, red spider	
Juniper	Juniper scale, red spider	
Privet	White peach scale, Red spider	
Magnolia	Magnolia scale, Red spider	Note: Do not combine with any other spray when spraying citrus.
Citrus	Scale, mealy bugs, white flies, mites	
Boxwood	Scale, mealy bugs, red spider	
Holly	Tea scale	
Sago Palm	Scale
