Dear Mr. Luedke:

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following comments:

- 1) Add under IF SWALLOWED: Do not give any liquid to a person.
- 2) Under the product name you must specify "For Homeowners Use Only" since it is not an Agricultural Use Product (No Agricultural Use Box).
- 3) The dormant season for fruit trees should be specified (Spring and Summer months?).

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Avoid contact with eyes or skin. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with fresh water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention. For skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. Harmful if swallowed. If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

	FIRST AID
If on skin or clothing	 Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If in eyes	 Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting – Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Fish and other aquatic life may be killed by this product. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Do not store, use or spill near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manuel inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not store near heat or open flame. Leave in original container until used. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Leave unwanted pesticide material in original container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

HOW TO USE: Dilute with water as per directions below. Spray plant thoroughly, making sure to get underside of leaves wet with spray.

DORMANT SPRAY ONLY: Plants – Peaches, Plums, Apples, Pears, Hackberry, Dogwood, Pecans, Oak, Birch, Chinaberry and Pine. Insects – San Jose Scale, Spider Mite eggs, Obscure Scale, Terrapin Scale, White Pecan Scale and Pine Needle Scale. Dilutions: Mix 10 tablespoons (5 ounces) in 1 gallon of water. Repeat application at 2 or 3 week intervals until scale is controlled. NOTE: Do not spray trees when temperature is below 45 F for a period of 24 to 48 hours because it may injure the trees. Be sure spray is agitated while using.

SPRING AND SUMMER SPRAY: Plants — Camellia, Azalea, Euonymus, Rose, Juniper, Privet, Magnolia, Citrus, Boxwood, Holly and Sage Palm. Insects — Tea Scale, Azalea Scale, Mealybugs, Red Spider Mites, Euonymus and Red Scale, Rose Scale, Juniper Scale, White Peach Scale, Magnolia Scale, and Whiteflies. Dilutions: Mix 5 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water. Repeat in 2 to 3 week intervals until pests are controlled. NOTE: Do not spray plants when temperature is above 90 F for a period of 24 to 48 hours as it may injure the plants. Do not combine with any other spray when spraying citrus.
