**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
Shake can well before using. Remove cover cap. Hold can 24 to 48 inches from plant. Push button down, using short bursts per plant. Spray weeds until thoroughly wet with white foamy spray. Avoid spray mist drift to desirable plants.

For best results spray the following weeds when young and growing. Control: (1) the plantain, clover, henbit, chickweed, ragweed, bindweed, dock, sheep sorrel, pennywort, knotweed, wild onion, wild pigweed, pigweed, purslane, and certain other broadleaf weeds. If weeds are more than 12 inches tall, it is best to mow them first. Weeds grow for about a week before spraying. Some hard to kill weeds may need retreating in about 2 to 3 weeks. Treated weeds do not die and dry up in 2 or 3 days but they stop growing and wilt. After 12 to 14 days the treated weeds usually disappear.

Do not apply to areas underlain by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Avoid spraying on lawn grasses.

**CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.** Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing and inhaling spray. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. For eyes get medical attention.

Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

Avoid contamination of irrigation ditches and water used for domestic purposes.

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture, incinerate or store above 120° F.

Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.

For best results spray the following weeds when young and growing: Dandelion, thistle, plantain, clovers, henbit, chickweeds, ragweed, bindweed, duck sheep sorrel, pennywort, knotweed, wild onion, oxalis, pigweed, poison oak, poison ivy and certain other broadleaf weeds. If weeds are more than 12 inches tall, it is best to mow them. Let mowed weeds grow for about a week before spraying. Some hard to kill weeds may need retreating in about 2 to 3 weeks. Treated weeds do not die and dry up in 2 or 3 days, but they stop growing and wilt. After 12 to 14 days the treated weeds usually disappear.

Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Avoid spraying on lawn grasses.
