**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**STORAGE:** Store in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in original container. Put safety covers back on bottle after you are done. **WARNING:** PESTICIDE. Irrigate, unopened pesticide material is not to be used. Use immediately after original container is sealed. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding it.

**HOW TO USE AND APPLY:** Determine size of spraying job. For lawns and vegetables measure the area to be sprayed. For all other applications spray as a thorough cover spray. Make applications when insects first appear. Repeat applications as needed or as noted in the rate chart. Use caution around children, pets, and people. Measure and mix the amount of spray and water as indicated on the chart. Spray as directed in rate chart. Use coarse droplets spray for lawns, trees and shrubs. Thorough coverage is important. Flush sprayer with clean water after each use. **NOTE:** Thoroughly wet down grass a few hours before applying to eliminate water from thoroughly after application.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**STORAGE:** Store in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in original container. Put safety closure back on bottle after use and before storing.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Unwanted pesticide material leave in original container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

### HOW TO MIX AND APPLY

Determine size of spraying job. For lawns and vegetables measure 1 area to be sprayed. For all other applications apply as a thorough coverage spray. Make applications when insects first appear. Repeat application as needed or as noted in the rate chart. Use clean sprayer. Carefully measure and mix the amount of spray and water as suggested in 1 chart. Spray as directed in rate chart. Use coarse drenching sprays for lawns, soil, and other surface applications. Use medium-fine mist sprayer for trees and plants. Thorough coverage is important. Flush sprayer with clean water after each use. **NOTE:** Thoroughly wet down grass a few days before applying for White Grubs of Japanese Beetle, European or Southern Chafers, Borers. Water grass thoroughly after application.
