VEGETABLES: (1) Beans, (2) Cucumbers, (2) Peppers, (2) Squash, (2) Tomatoes, Pacific Tomato Russet, Tropical and Red Spider mites. Apply at the first sign of mite buildup and repeat as necessary. Do not use on eggplant. **ORNAMENTAL HOUSE PLANTS, FLOWERS, SHRUBS:** Red Spider, Cyclamin, Spruce, Tropical mites. Spray plants thoroughly, making sure tops and bottoms of leaves are covered. Repeat in 7 to 10 days if necessary. *In California use 1 ounce per 1.5 gallons of water.
