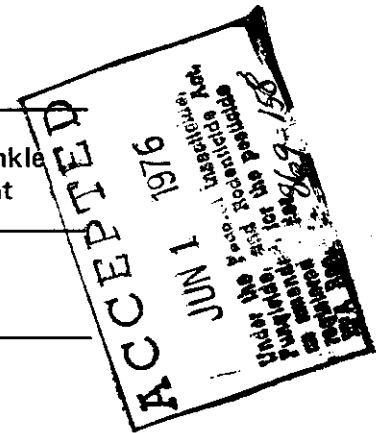
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply Green Light Dursban* Granules insecticide uniformly to home lawns, flowerbeds, under shrubbery, and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand fertilizer spreader or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using Granules at the rate of 5 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half required amount of product in one direction, then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 150 gallons of water per 3,000 sq. ft. so to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Re-treat as necessary.

Note: See directions on fertilizer or granule spreader for setting to apply 5 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils use twice the rate of Granules shown on table. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.

USE PRECAUTIONS:

Keep children and pets off treated areas until material is washed into soil and grass is dry. Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies.

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Dispose of empty container and wastes by burning or by burying in non-cropland away from water supplies.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. MAY BE HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. Do not take internally. Avoid eye contact. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water, and get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use.
